PLEASE DO NOT SEND BIRTHDAY INVITATIONS TO SCHOOL!!

I need to make you all aware that I CANNOT let students pass out birthday invitations at school. Please do not send invitations to school with your child.

There are three exceptions:

- 1--If you want to invite our entire class, then your child may pass out invitations at school.
- 2--If you have a daughter and she wants to invite every girl in our class, then she may pass out invitations at school.
- 3--If you have a son and he wants to invite every boy in our class, then he may pass out invitations at school.

Please do not send invitations to school for your child to give to a student in another class. Call me and I will help you find the child your child wants to invite.

Too many feelings get hurt as a result of birthday invitations. Sometimes I still have folks who come to school and wait outside our classroom and try to pass out invitations as the kids leave to go home. Or I have folks who come before school to pass out invitations to kids before coming into the building. Please, please do not send or bring invitations to school at any time. If you need help finding a child (children), please call me. I will be happy to help you get in touch with the child (children) your first grader wants to invite.

After I get all the phone numbers and emails for the kids in our class, I will make a list and send a copy home to you. This way you'll be able to reach the kids in our class. I am happy to help you find a child in another class. Thank you for your understanding in this sensitive matter!
